During the summer, we would like your student in the middle school class to read *The Life of the Spider* by Jean Henri Fabre, *The Hobbit* by J. R. R. Tolkien, and chapters from *An/Our Island Story* by H. E. Marshall.

We have chosen these books with a couple of thoughts in mind. The middle school class is entering the years that transition to high school. They will start a thorough treatment of United States history, beginning with English history. They will spend the summer covering the period that students in a school like ours would have covered in the primary years. These books will tie into the historical times addressed next year.

Students in this class are expect to read a chapter and tell it to you. They must write a short narration in the reading journal provided.
