### **Khan Academy Math**


(1) If your child is doing Khan Academy, they should do 45 minutes a day as assigned. When logging in to Khan, click the number the student's name to see assignments. Once all assignments are finished, check the time by clicking "Progress" as shown in screen shot. If more minutes are needed, your child can look for more lesson within the assigned course.

(2) If your child struggles with a lesson, make sure the work is being written down. Sometimes students rely too much on mental calculations. Encourage them to ask for hints or watch related videos. Another option is to send me a picture or a screenshot. While waiting for a reply, they can do other work (either on Khan or other classes).

(3) If you have extenuating circumstances, please get in touch with me so I can make accommodations.
